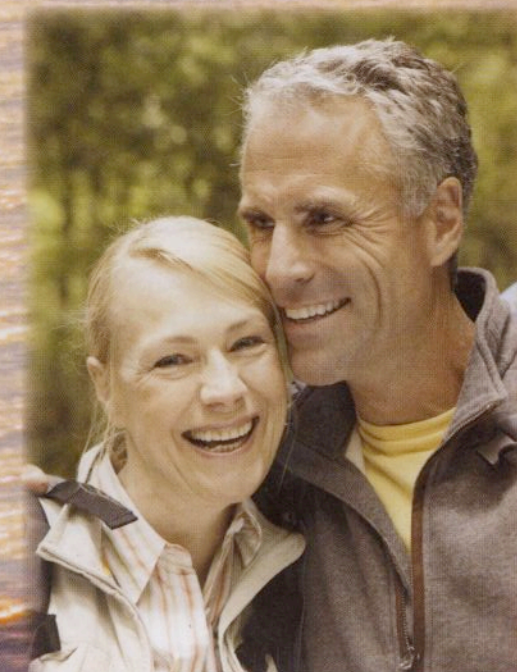

Legacy Giving: What does this mean?

A legacy gift is your opportunity to reflect your commitment to the great work of the Camrose United Church. Most often your gift will be made from your estate or accumulated financial assets. It's your opportunity to leave a lasting gift – a personal legacy!

Legacy Giving is different from other kinds of financial support

Your commitment, by way of your financial gift, is separate and distinct from all other church funds. It is not intended to cover regular and on-going operational requirements of the church.

You can designate your Legacy Gift

Generous donations of \$10,000 or more, in real estate, securities, annuities, or as outlined in your will, can be specifically designated, pertaining to use of same.

Discuss your gift or intent to give with your family and professional advisor(s).

Legacy Gifts will be disbursed in a unique, but clearly defined formula

The Fund will increase in value until undesignated gifts and income earned reaches \$50,000. After that, one half of income earned and one half of additional undesignated gifts will be treated as proceeds available for disbursement. Once the Fund reaches \$100,000 all income and undesignated gifts will be treated as proceeds available for disbursement.

The money from the Fund will not be used to cover regular and ongoing operational requirements of the church. Rather, money from the Fund will be used for development and enhancement of the ministry of Camrose United Church in areas such as the following:

- (a) "Reaching Up" – enabling members to grow in Christian faith through leadership courses/training/conferences, church-related camping; providing scholarships or grants to members for the purpose of attending theological colleges/educational institutions; developing aspects of worship (including music).
- (b) "Reaching Out" – outreach into the community for programs, institutions and agencies to which this congregation relates; supporting projects of The United Church of Canada at home and overseas, including, but not limited to, the Mission and Service Fund.
- (c) "Reaching In" – Capital improvements, debt reduction, or the building program of Camrose United Church.
